Students who have already completed their paramedic certification and who have maintained their license in good standing may apply to the A.S. emergency medical services program. This program offers the opportunity to reach educational goals without repetition of courses or clinical experiences already taken. The student may receive up to 30 hours of credit for their previously earned paramedic certificate. These credits may be applied only toward the Paramedic Core.
