# **Transfer Credit**

CSU is committed to helping students make the most of their previously earned academic credits, professional licenses, certificates and training programs. CSU also considers credit by examination, and knowledge learned by experiential or equivalent learning.

# **Scholarships**

Fire Scholarship—Each year, Columbia Southern University awards two scholarships to current fire science or fire administration students. Those that plan to enroll in a fire-related degree program are also eligible to apply. Each scholarship covers up to 60 credit hours toward one online degree program.
